## Day 1 - Friday - November 4: Overnight: San Diego, CA.

Transportation provided from Nacogdoches and Lufkin to DFW for flights to San Diego 12:20 P.M. - American #1939 departs DFW at 12:20 P.M. arriving San Diego at 1:30 P.M. (Current schedule is subject to change). Transportation provided by Holland America to our hotel.

## Day 2 - Saturday - November 5: Day in San Diego

Your day in San Diego. Easy going San Diego embodies the Southern California surfer town fantasy, with its more than 300 days of sun, mild year-round temperatures and accessible, sporty pastimes and tourist attractions. You can hike the Torrey Pines State Natural Reserve to get a glimpse of whale migrations or go sailing in the bay. But the sixth-largest city in the United States is surprisingly nuanced, with distinctive neighborhoods: Old Town, North Park, Point Loma and Coronado are all within a few miles of the port, while the bustling Gaslamp Quarter and Little Italy are within walking distance. Afternoon transfers from hotel to ship. **Ship sails at 4:00 P.M**.

#### Day 3 - Sunday - November 6: Avalon, California 7:00 A.M. - 4:00 P.M.

Catalina, one of California's Channel Islands, lies offshore about 40 kilometers (25 miles) southwest of Los Angeles. The island's distinctive landscape—a mix of mountains, canyons, beaches and coves—is mostly undeveloped outside the charming port town of Avalon. Here you'll find a beach community with a Mediterranean flair reminiscent of a quieter time, and one that seems far from the traffic and bustle of Los Angeles. Sailboats bob in crystal-clear waters in the crescent-shaped bay, and the main street is lined with boutiques and restaurants in brightly painted bungalows. You can easily explore Avalon in a few hours, as nearly everything is concentrated in a few blocks. That leaves the afternoon for exploring the rest of the island. Today most of the island is owned by the Catalina Island Conservancy, which works hard to preserve its flora and fauna, from Catalina Island foxes to the bald eagles flying overhead and the schools of bright orange Garibaldi fish swimming in the bay.

#### Day 4 - Monday - November 7: Santa Barbara, California 8:00 A.M. - 5:00 P.M.:

Santa Barbara is undisputedly one of the most popular destinations in a state with some pretty serious competition; in many other states it would surely be the star attraction by far. That's how rich the city is, with its gorgeous buildings erected by the city's early Spanish settlers, as well as later mission revival architecture. And, of course, it occupies a prime spot along the famous oceanfront Highway 101, with a backdrop of the Santa Ynez Mountains and a long stretch of beach with the undeveloped Channel Islands offshore. No wonder many Santa Barbarans can trace their roots here for generations—no one wants to leave.

## Day 5 - Tuesday - November 8: Monterey, California 8:00 A.M. - 5:00 P.M.

One of California's most beautiful coastal cities, Monterey boasts a charming downtown, with historic buildings, and a world-class aquarium. It's also the setting of several John Steinbeck novels.

#### Day 6 - Wednesday - November 9: San Francisco 8:00 A.M. - 11:00 P.M.

San Francisco, California, has long been America's shining city by the sea: a beacon on the West Coast that boomed during the gold rush of 1849 and, for much of the 20th century, embodied the sunny California dream. It has always been a city of dreamers, a place that appeals both to the country's counterculture and also, ironically, to those looking to strike it rich. The Summer of Love unfolded here in 1967, while today it is the epicenter of the Internet economy, enjoying yet another period of expansion. One thing has remained constant throughout its colorful history—the city's enviable location at the tip of a peninsula separating San Francisco Bay from the Pacific Ocean. Around every corner and from every hilltop, views of the water and the city's bridges wait to be photographed.

## Day 7 - Thursday - November 10: Days at Sea 12:00 A.M. - 11:59 P.M.

## Day 8 - Friday - November 11: Ensenada, Mexico 6:00 P.M. - 11:00 P.M.

Nicknamed the Pearl of the Pacific, with the Pacific Ocean to the west and a mountain range to the east. Ensenada is Baja California's third largest city and one of its commercial and cultural hubs. Evening Shore Excursions are available.

## Day 9 - Saturday - November 12 Return to San Diego.
